Abstract of the talk: The relationships among obesity, diabetes and mood or bipolar disorders have been increasingly recognized over the past decade. In 2009, a position statement was published in the journal European Psychiatry which called for diabetes and cardiovascular risk factor screening in psychiatric patients including patients with mood disorders. There are four main reasons why patients with mood disorders are more likely to suffer from obesity and diabetes, namely the effects of medications, the presence of psychiatric co-morbidities, behavioural factors and the similar pathophysiologies among mood disorders, obesity and diabetes. As regards similar pathophysiologies among mood disorders, obesity and diabetes, I would like to propose three mechanisms from the approaches of cells, cellular organelles and inflammatory mediators which may potentially give us insights into new medications for mood disorder patients. Controversies arising from various clinical trials will be discussed.
